It would be very helpful if the written opinions or the testimony summary on technical matters were filed and sent on or before the pre-hearing conference on August 6, 2024, so that the Applicant and others will have an opportunity to respond at the evidentiary hearing scheduled to begin on August 12, 2024.

The Committee likely will be interested in your opinion about whether the proposed project improves the reliability and/or the safety of operation of the grid and the delivery of power in Arizona.

We would, of course, welcome your thoughts on any other legal or technical issues relevant to our statutory review that you feel we should consider.
